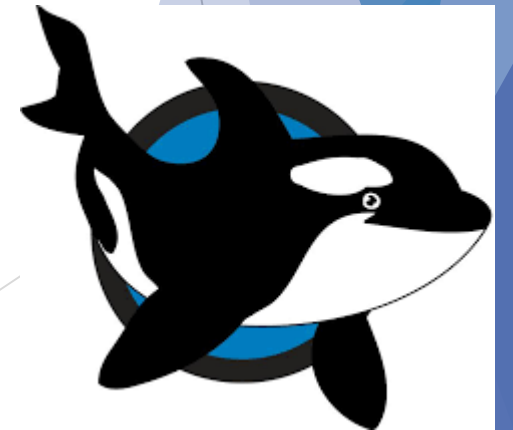

- ▶ What: Educational Effectiveness Survey by CEE conducted by the district in September 2019
- ▶ A snapshot in time
- ▶ Who was asked?
 - ▶ Staff 183
 - ▶ Parents 1174
 - ▶ Students grades 5-12 893
 - ▶ District office staff 18

Response Rate

▶ Staff	54%	n=99
▶ Parents	34%	n=402
▶ Students	80%	n=710
▶ DO staff	78%	n=14

- ▶ Set a course for the future

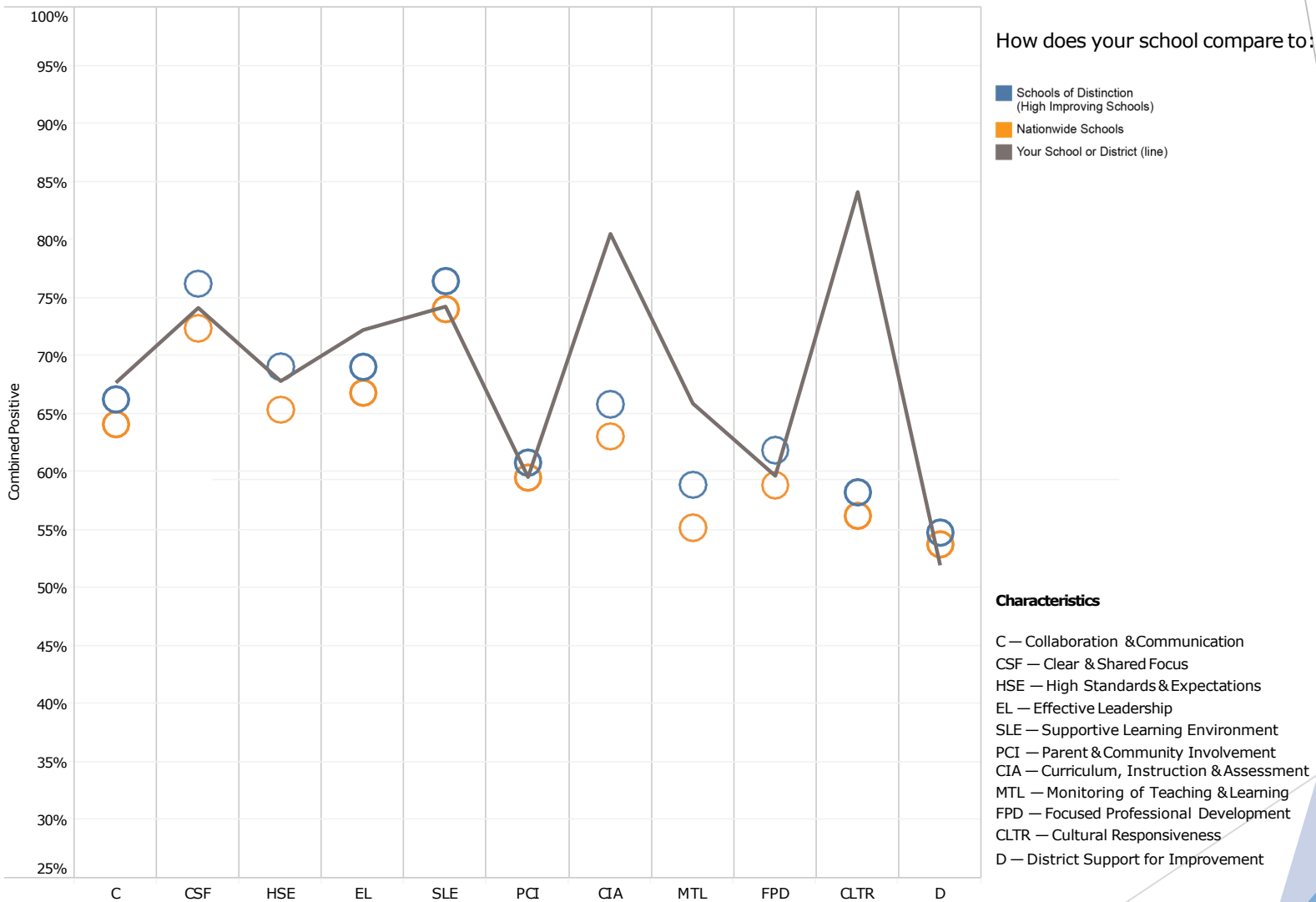

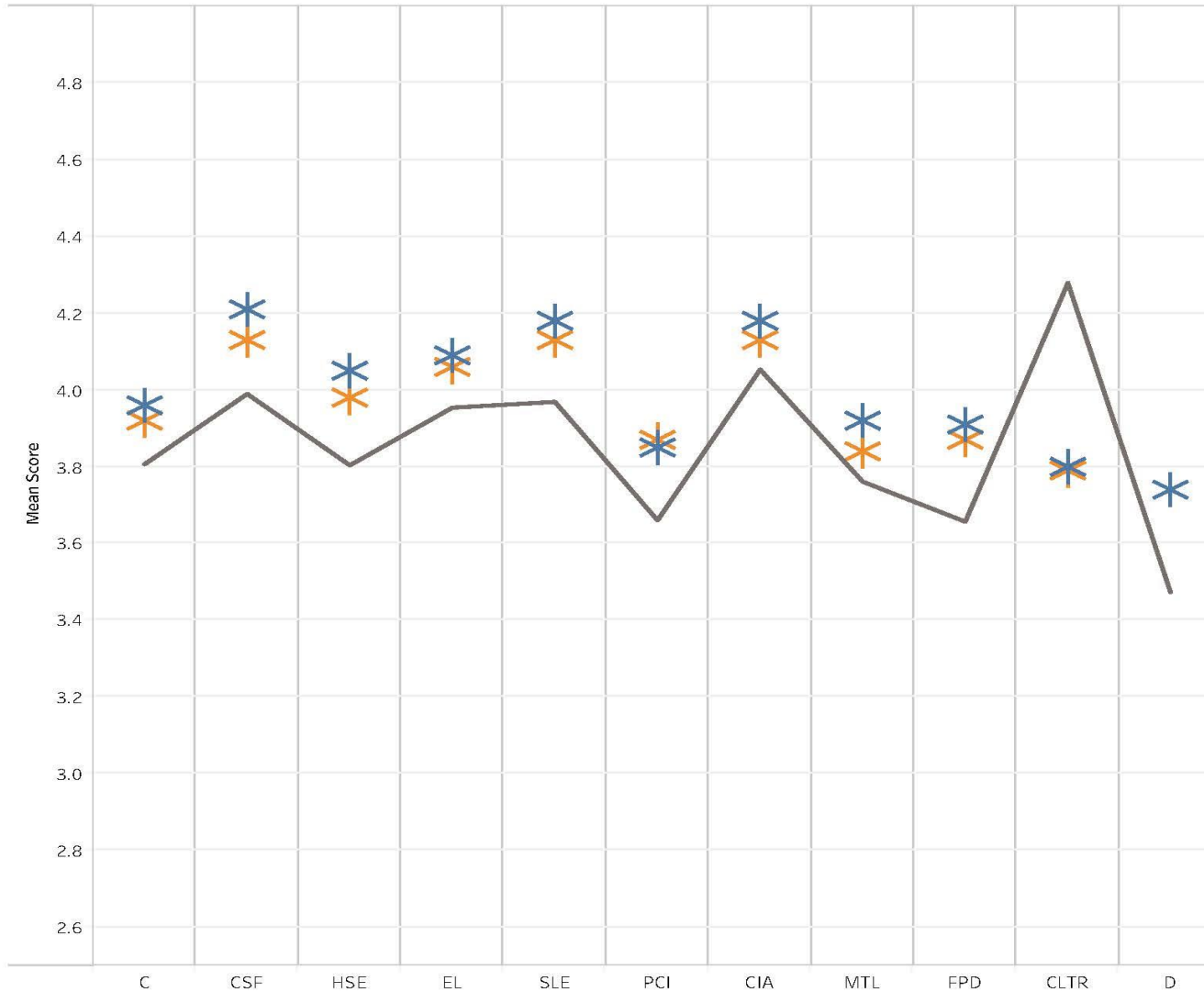


Comparison - Mean Scores

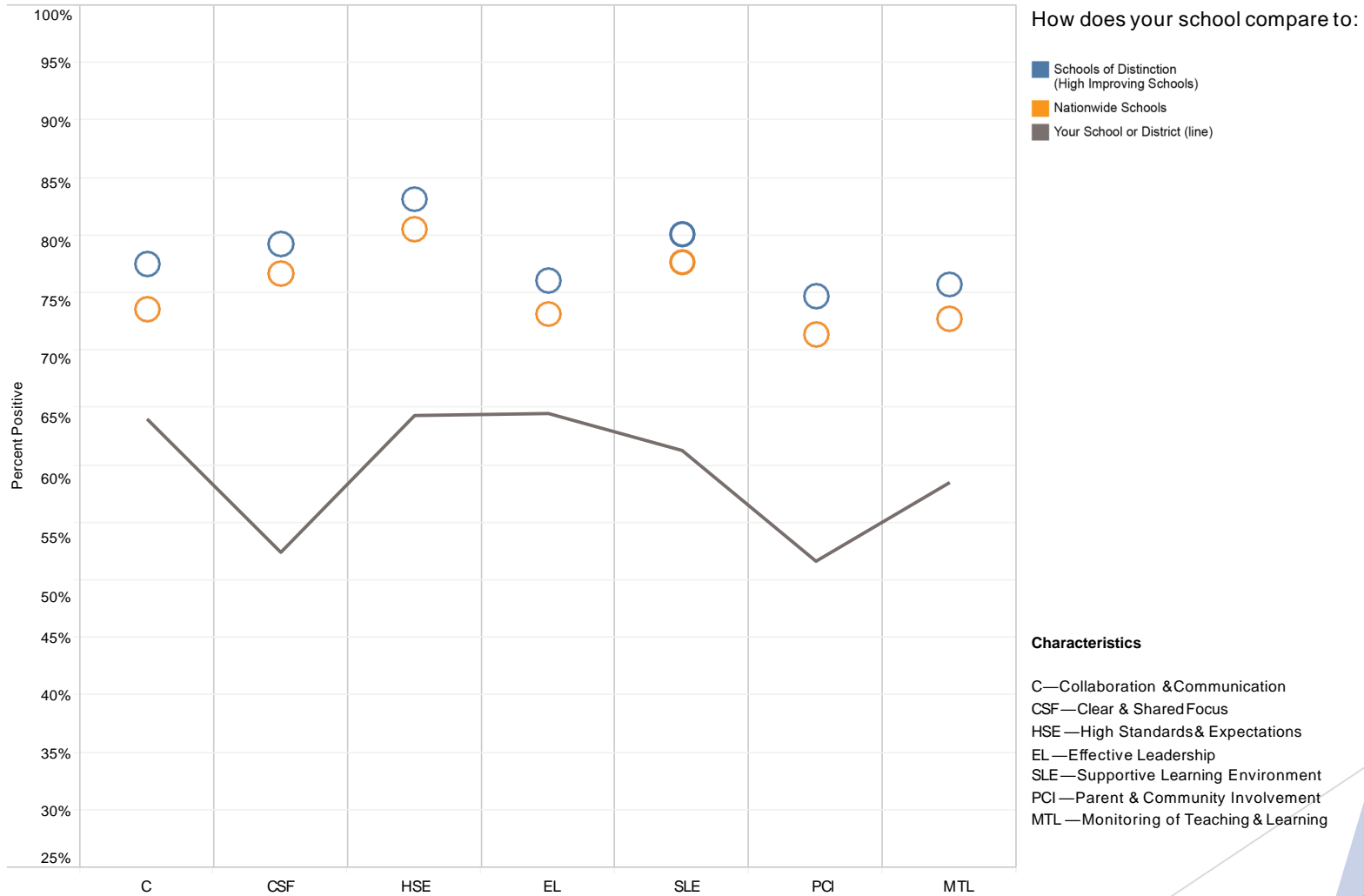

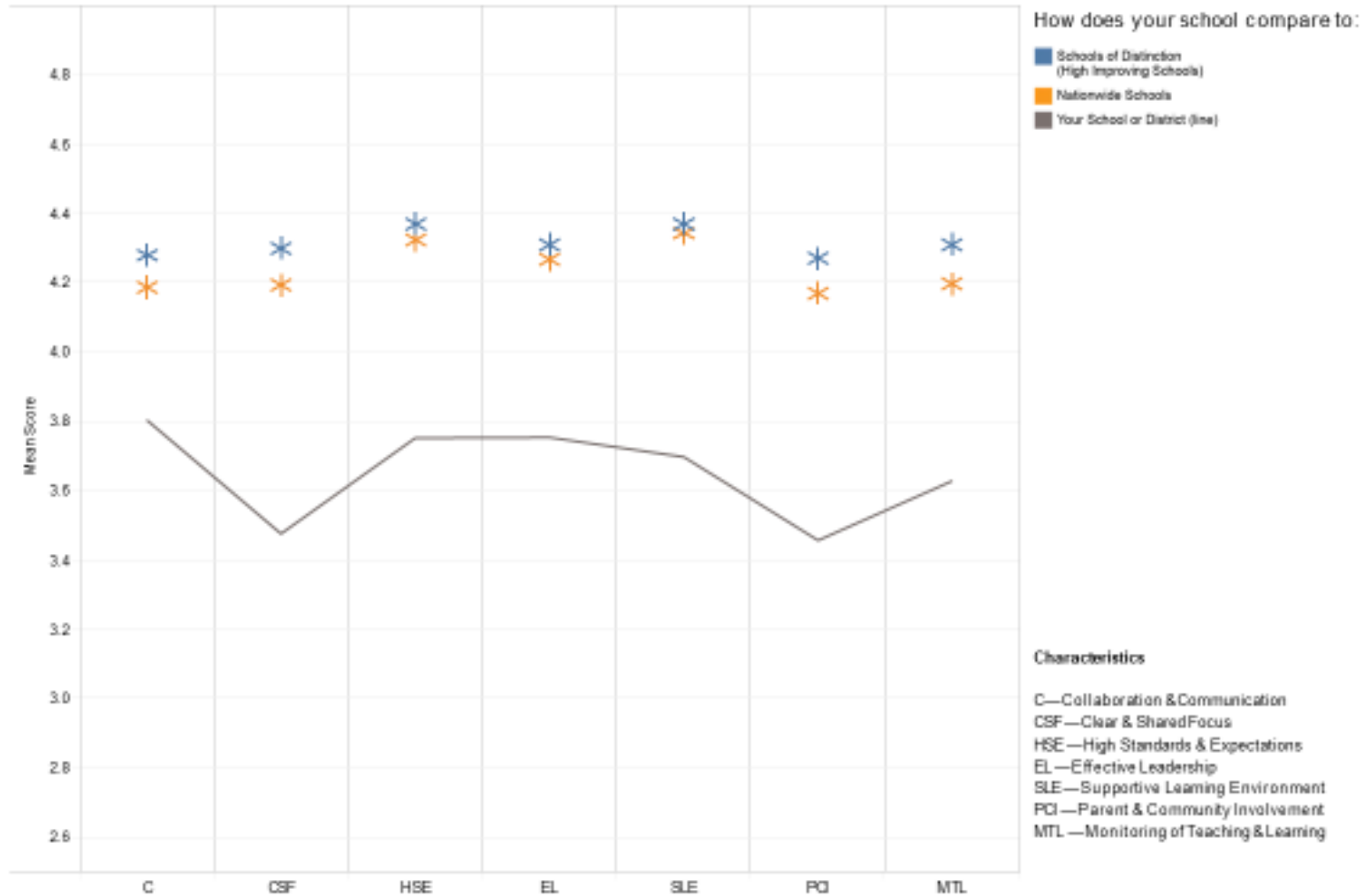


9 Characteristics Comparison - Mean Scores

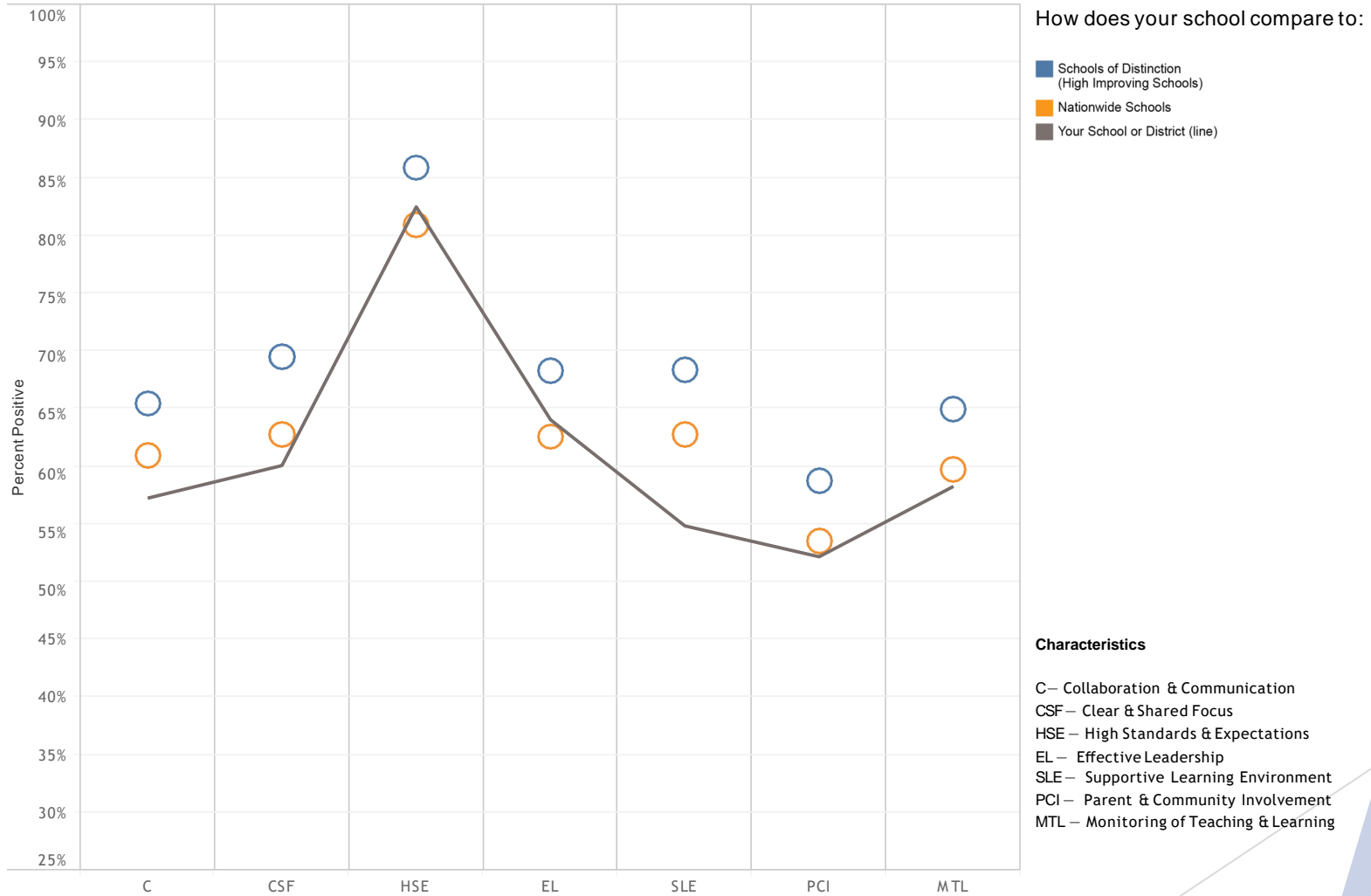

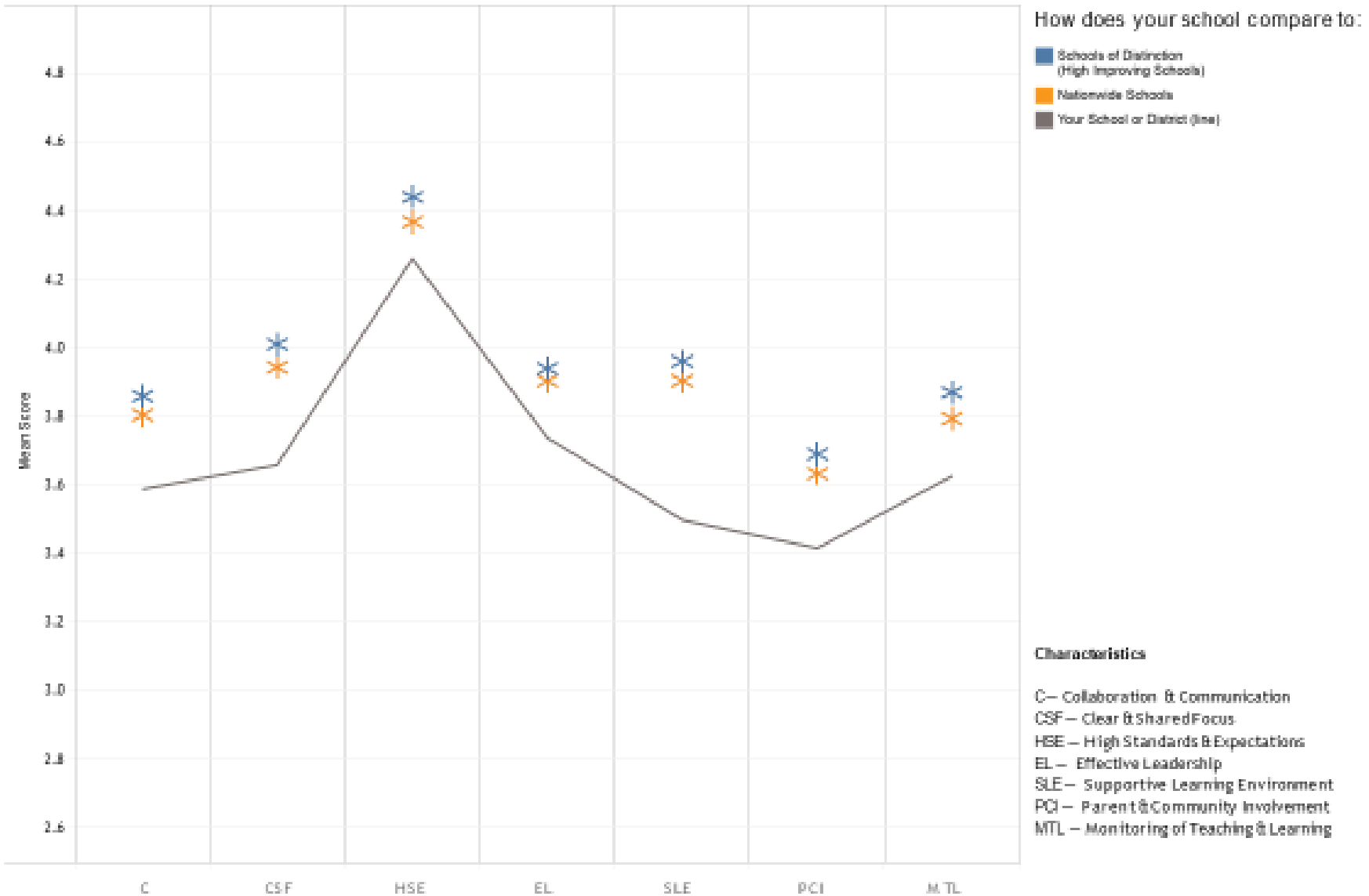

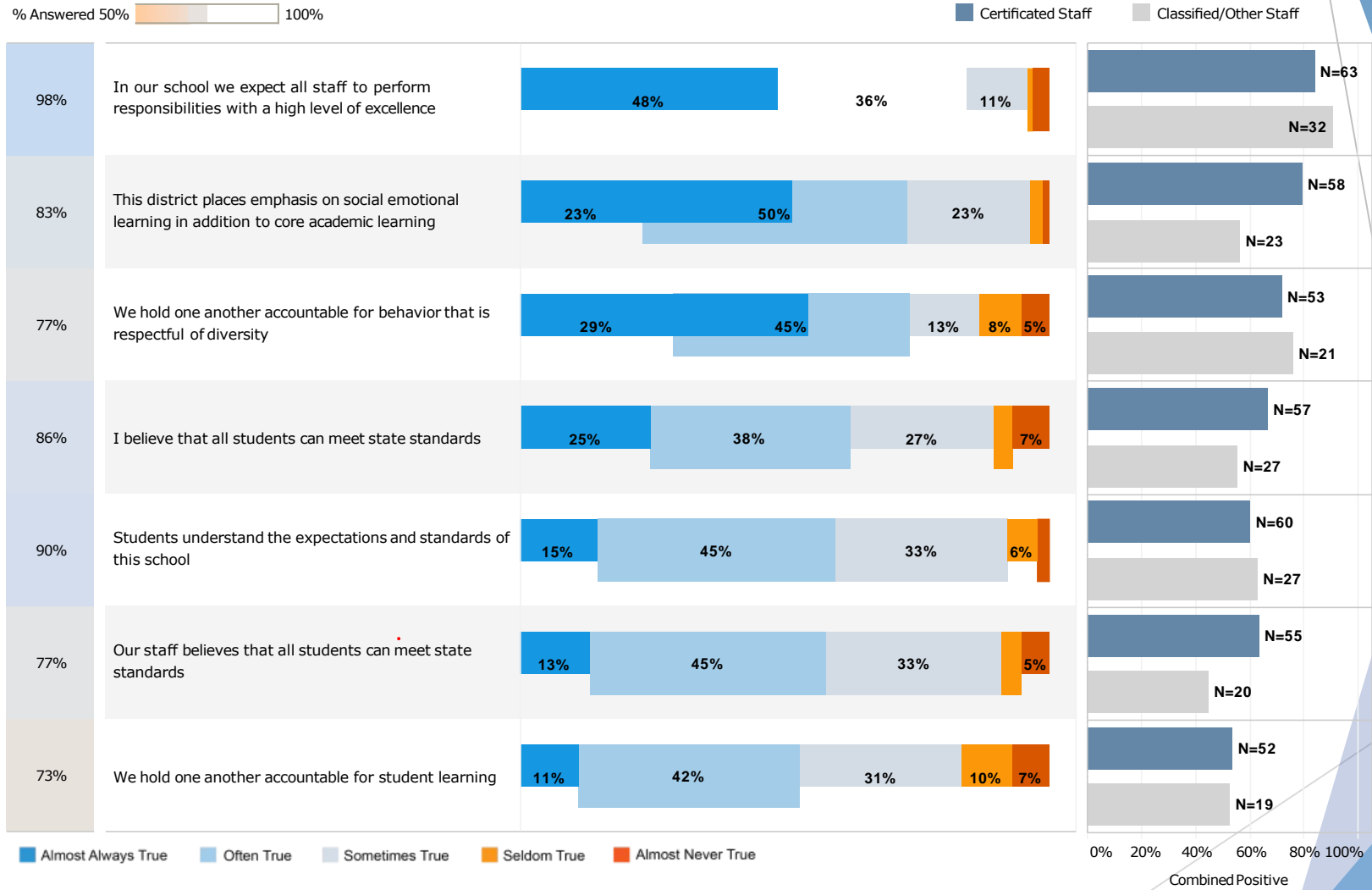

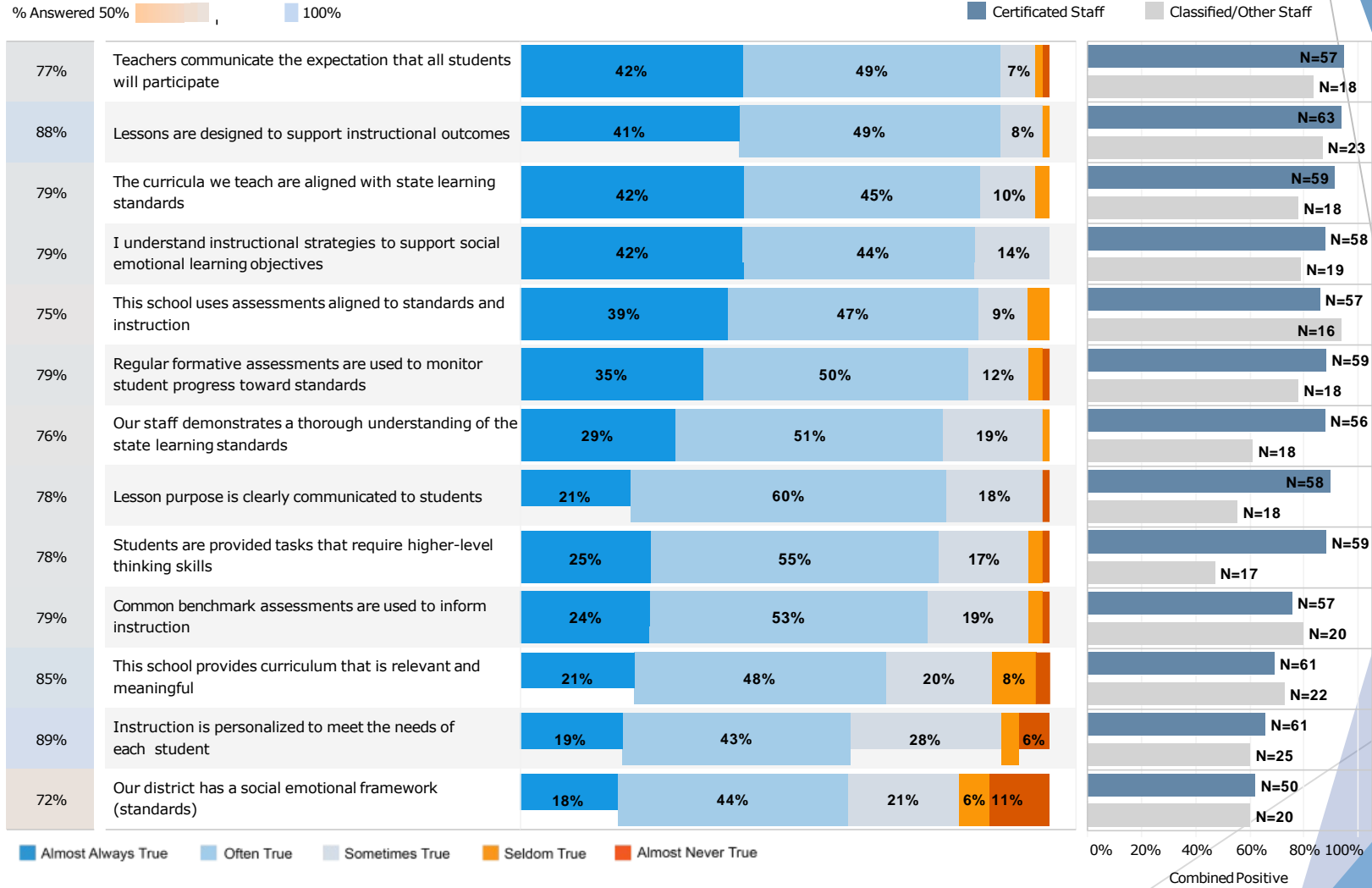

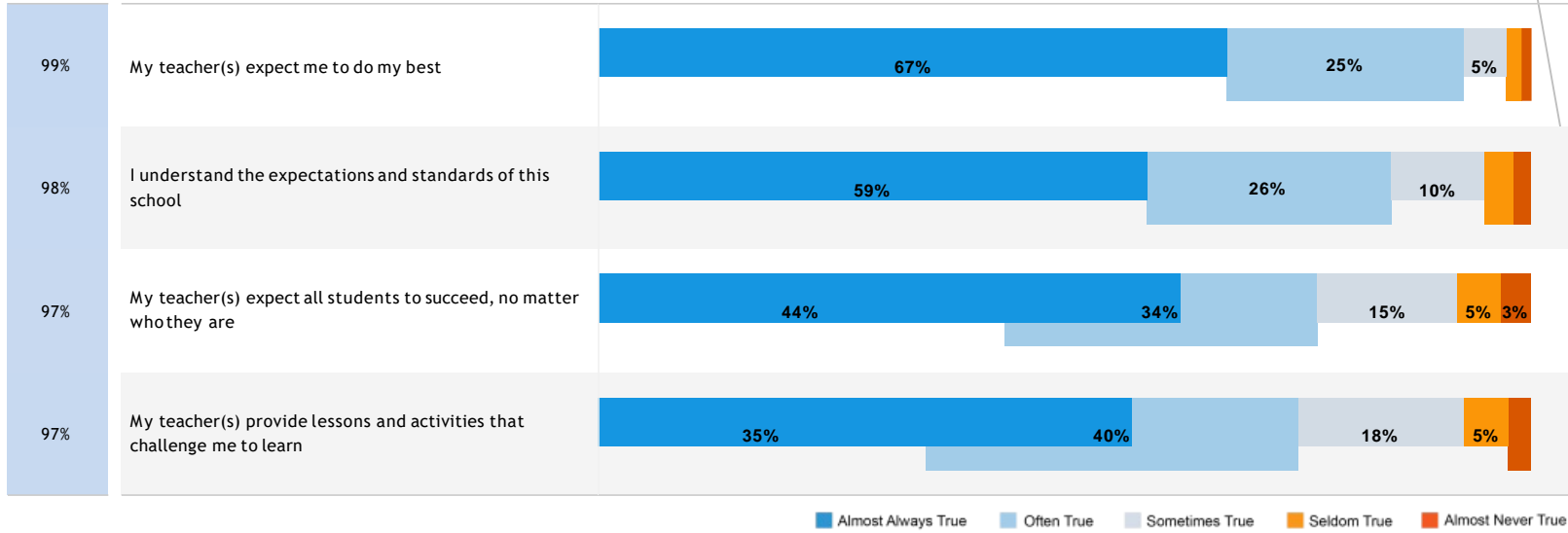

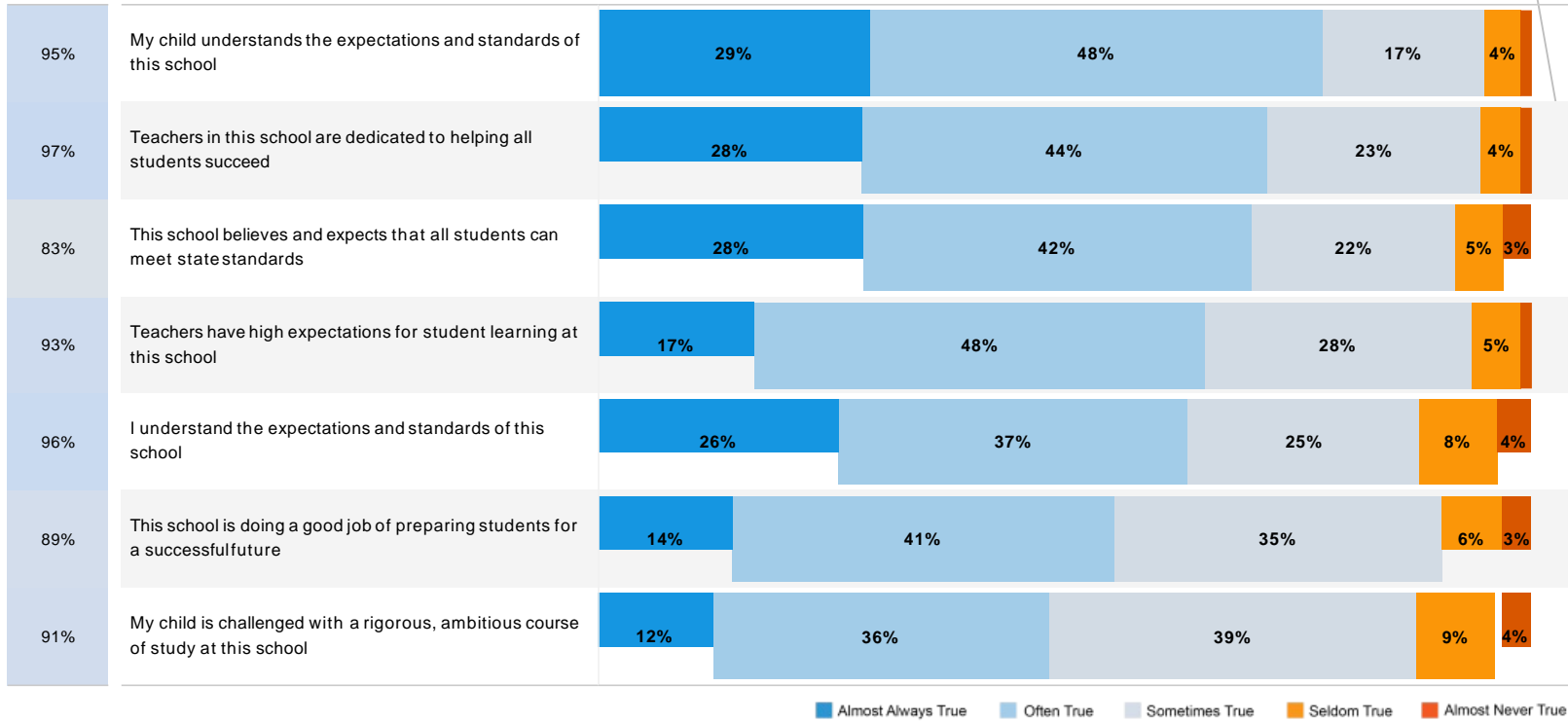

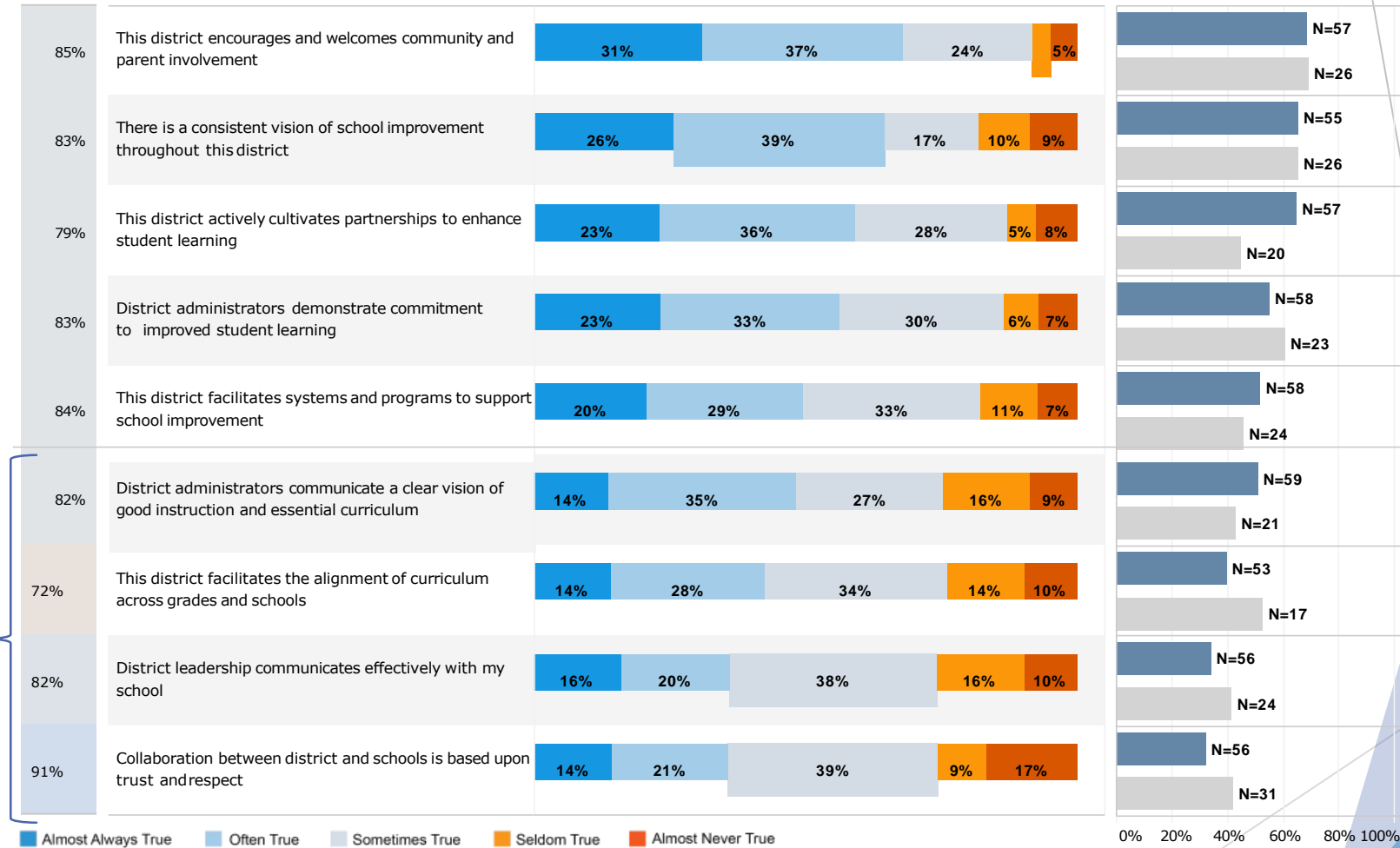

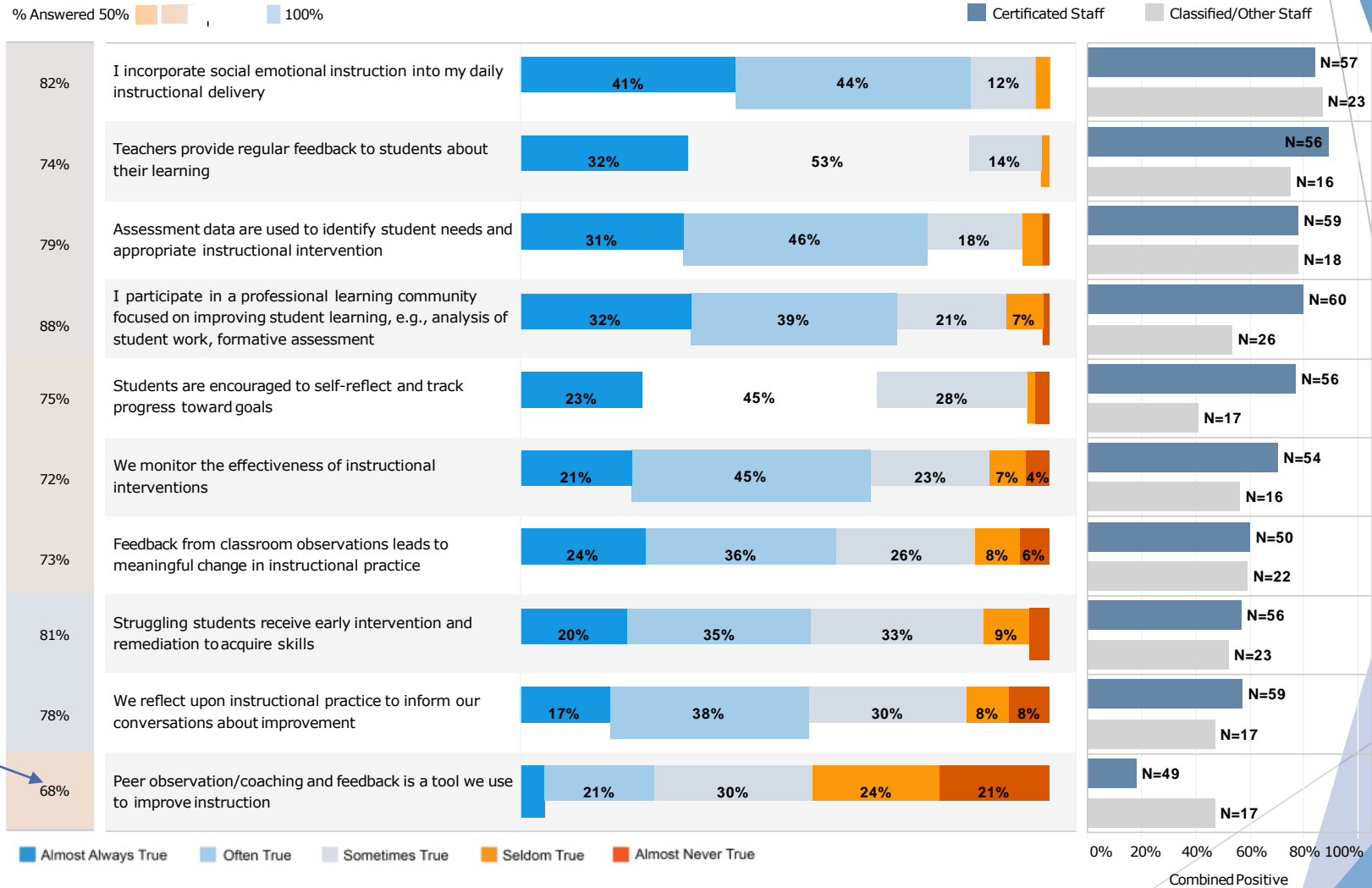

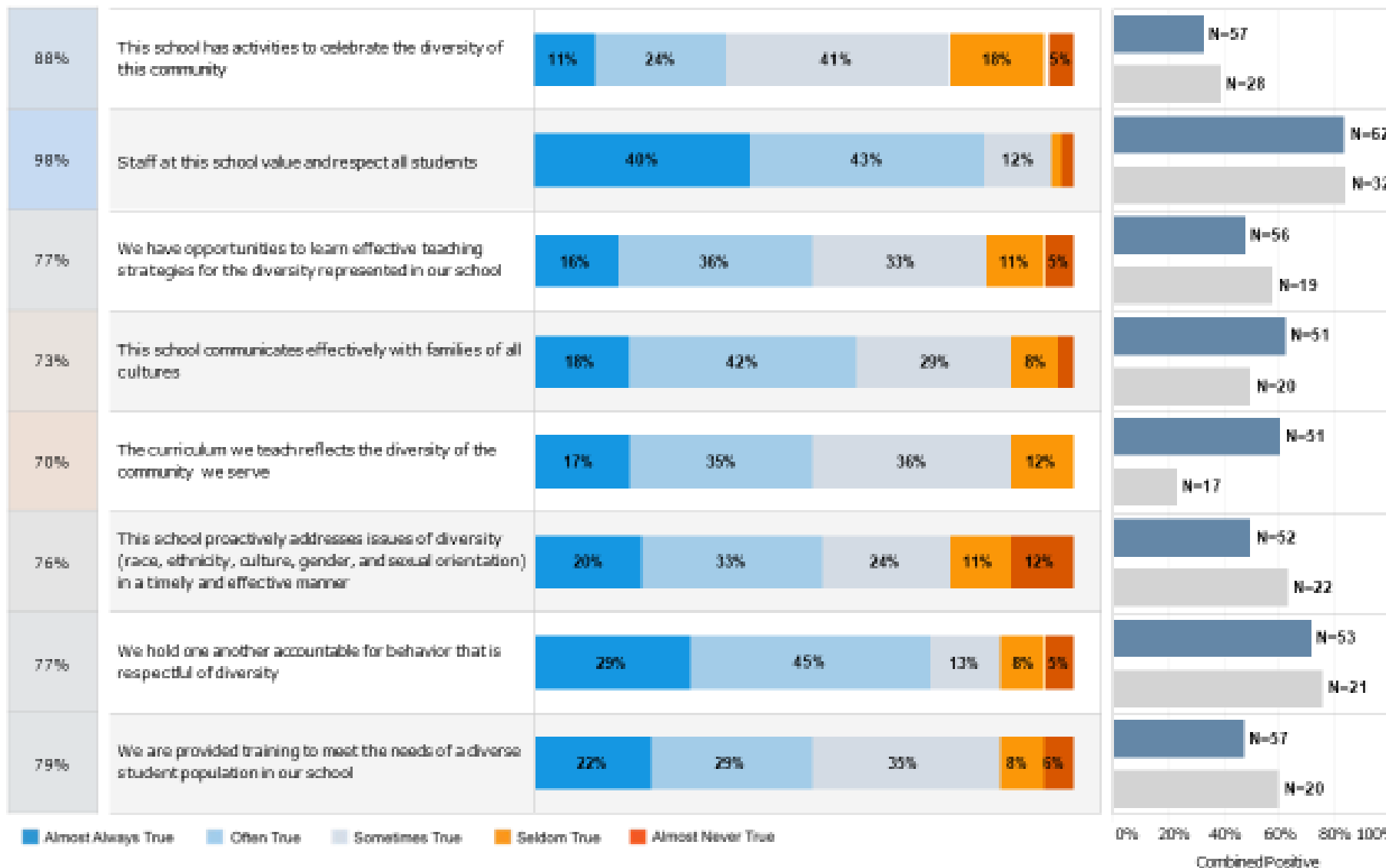

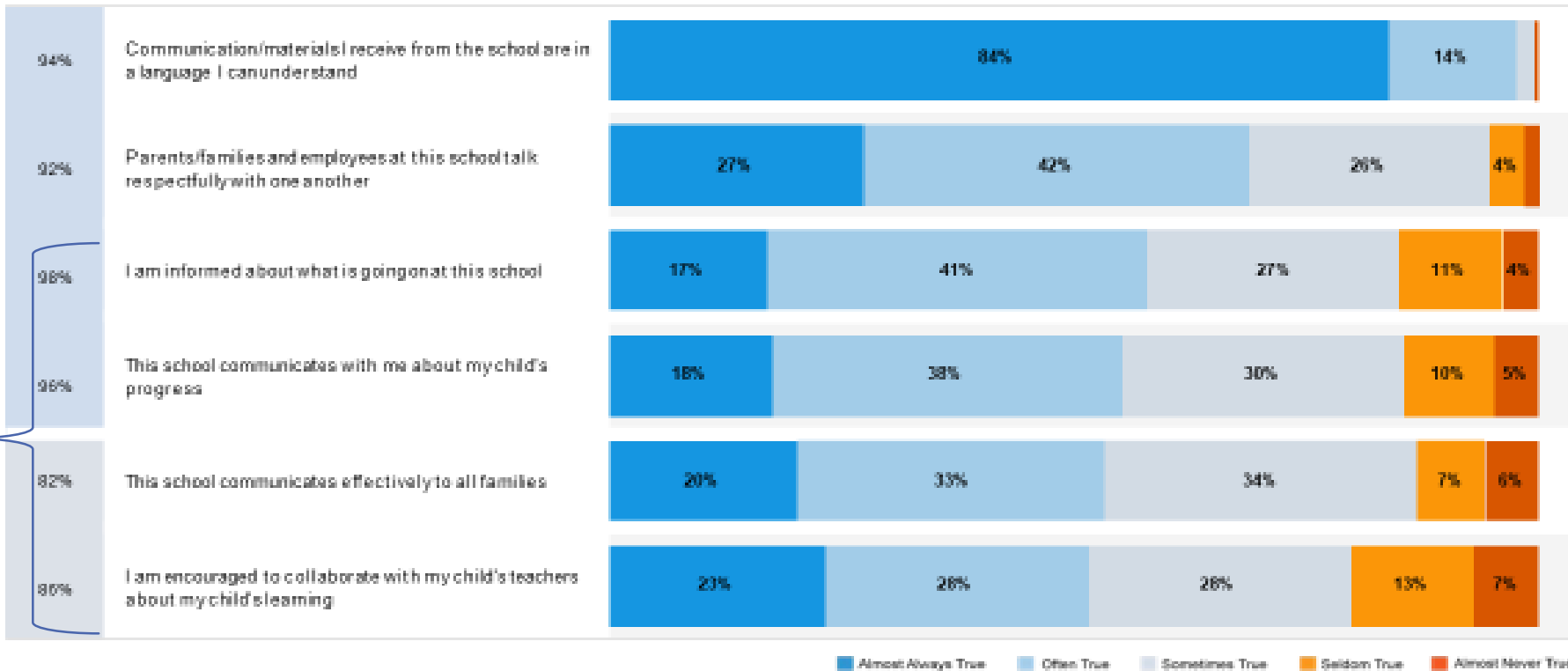

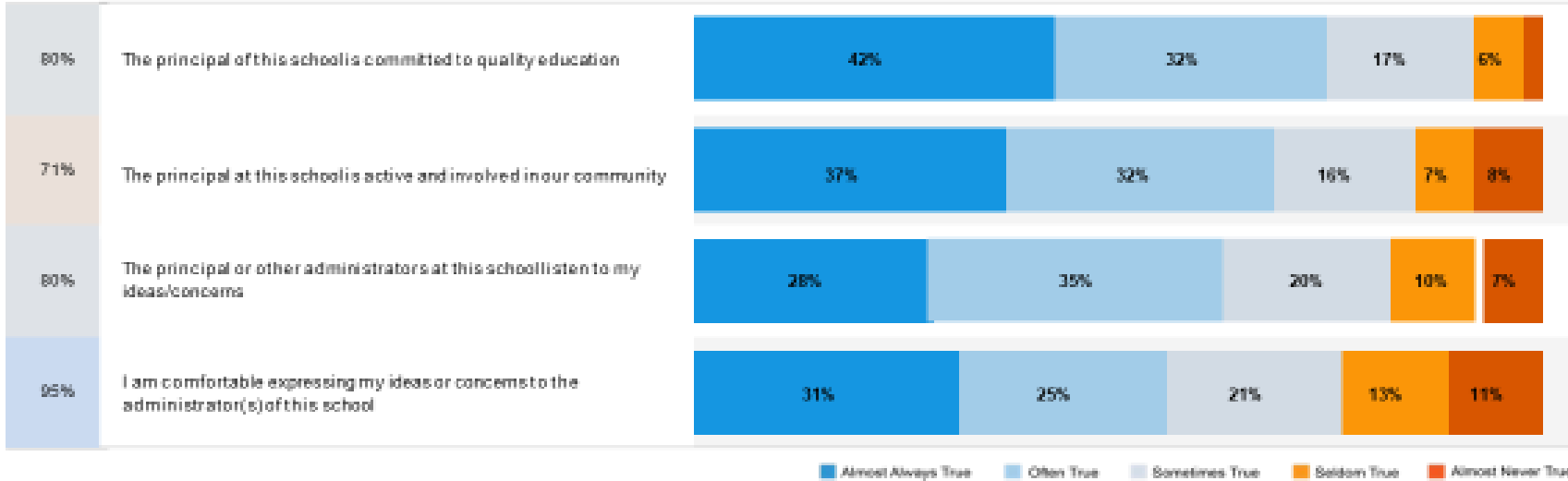

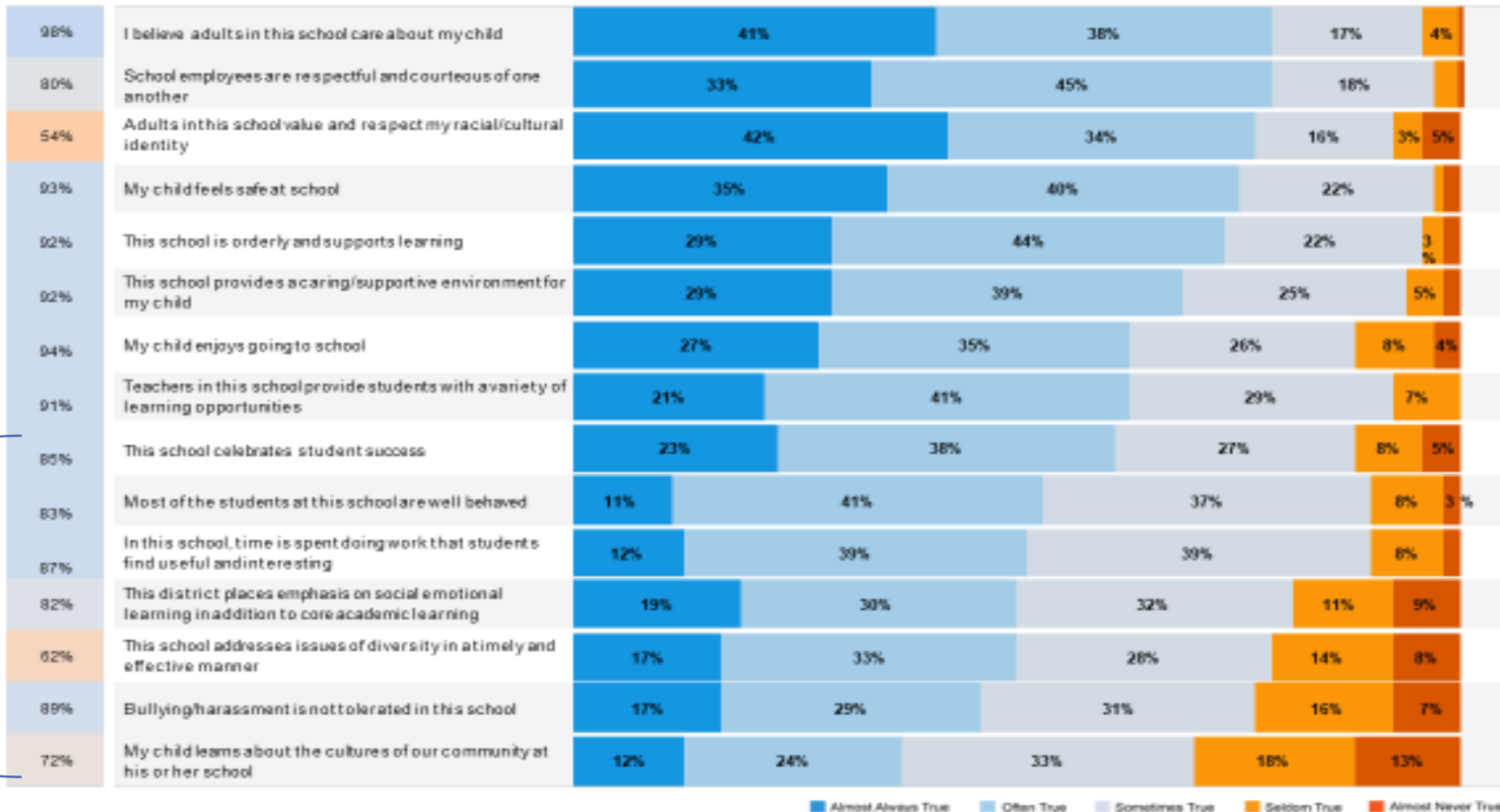

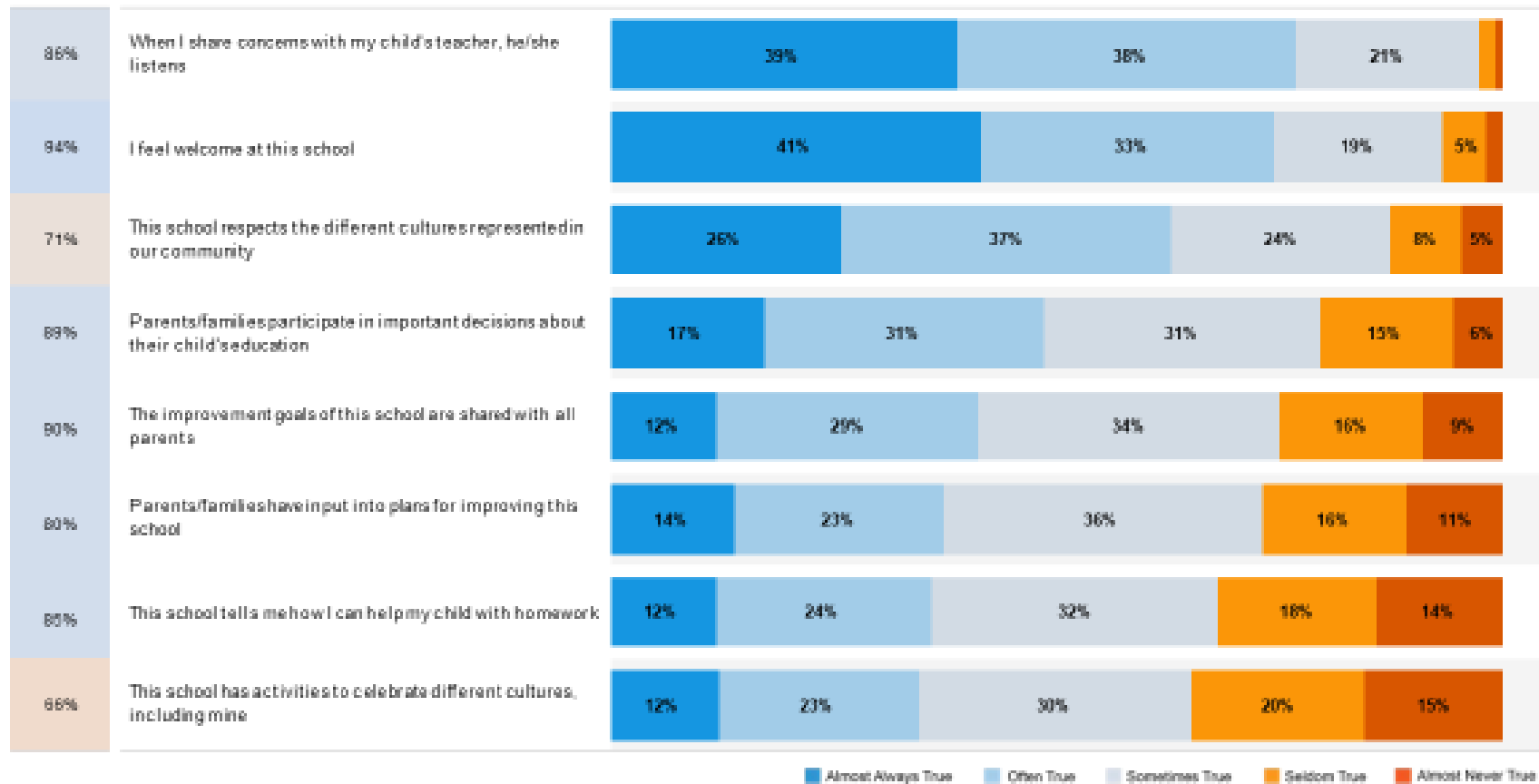

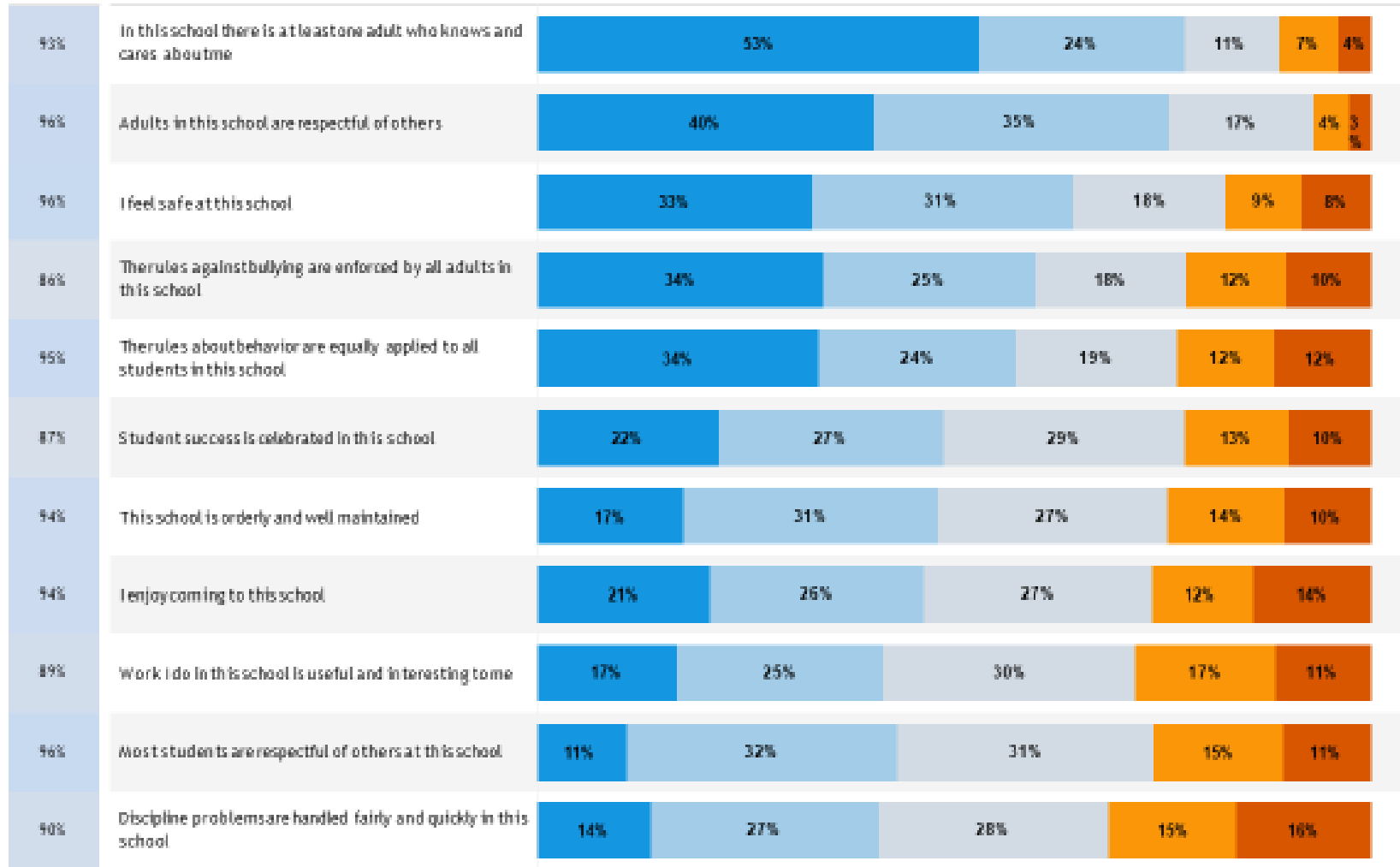

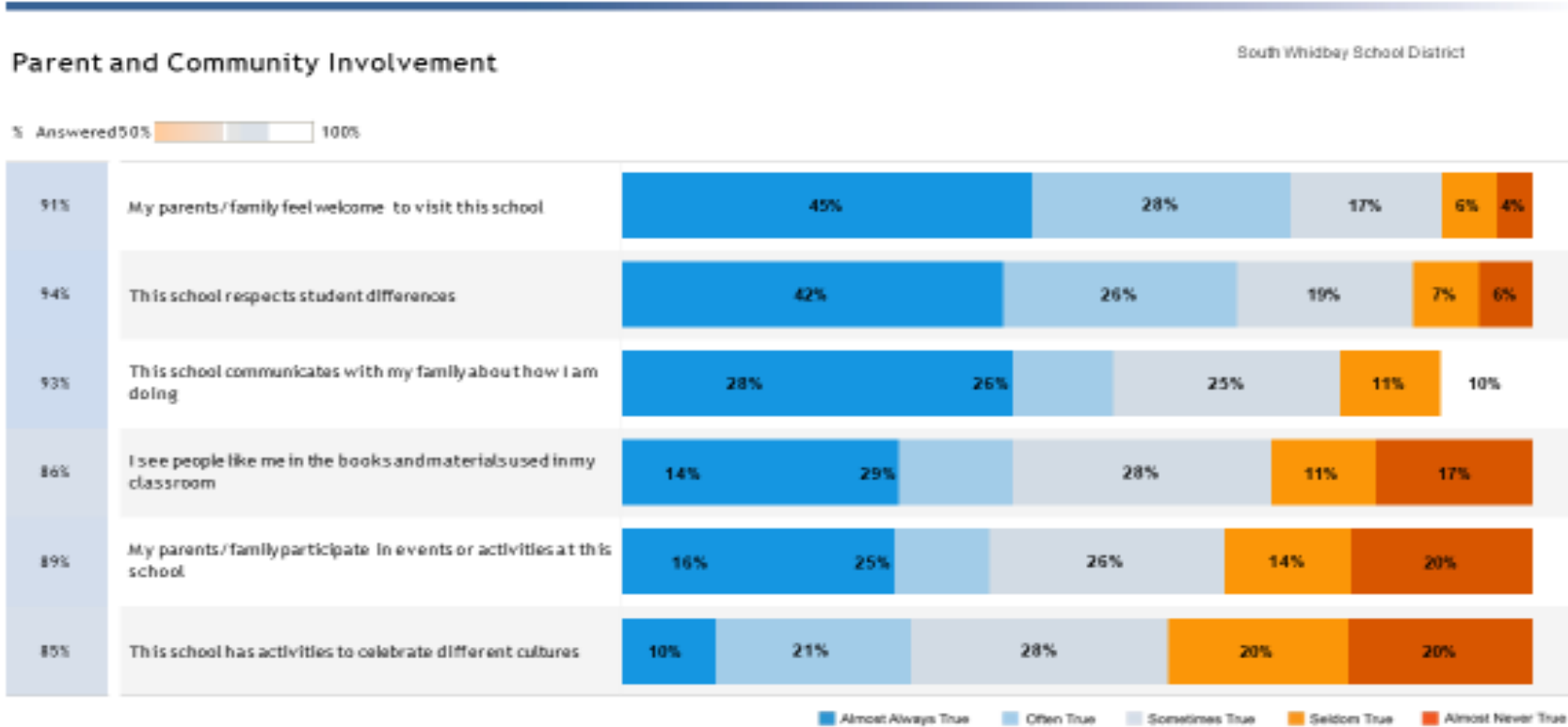

Social and Emotional Learning - Mean Scores

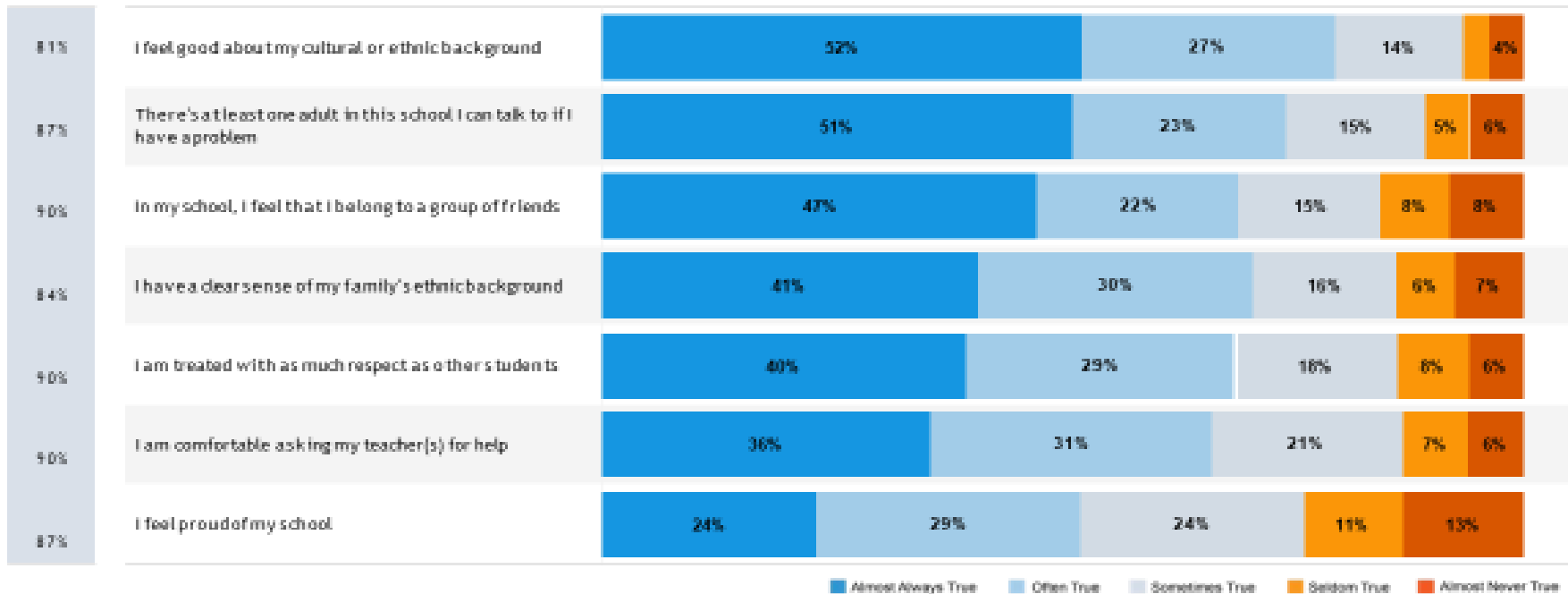
