Daily Symptom Checker Survey FAQ

How do students/faculty/staff access the Daily Symptom Checker?

Districts can choose to distribute the Daily Symptom Checker in two ways.

1. The first is an automated email distribution to parents and faculty/staff. A new survey link will be sent daily and **cannot be reused**. Parents will receive one link per child, and the surveys will be labeled with the child's name.
2. The second is via a reusable link that the district can provide. The link will ask users to input their name and email address each time.

What email address is the Daily Symptom Checker sent to?

The Daily Symptom Checker will be sent to the primary email address on file in the Skyward system. For students, the primary email address will always be that of the primary parent or guardian.

Can I receive the Daily Symptom Checker link as a text message?

Yes, if you receive the daily emails, you can enter your phone number into the survey to receive SMS messages in the future. If you opt-in to SMS messages, you will continue to receive email messages.

How do I share my results?

Results will be emailed to you as well as displayed at the end of the Symptom Checker Survey. We recommend that you take a screenshot of the certification message and/or print the email certification to present at school each day.

Do I need to answer the Symptom Checker Survey if I am fully remote?

No, the Daily Symptom Checker is intended for individuals who will be present at school or district buildings.

My district provided a reusable link, but it says I have already taken the survey. What do I do?

Sometimes your browser history will save yesterday's response or a response from another student if you are completing the survey for multiple children. To resolve this, clear your browser history or open the link in "Private Browsing" or "Incognito" mode.
