



Langley Middle School will no longer be used for students as of September 2017.

Students in grades 7 and 8 in September (current 6 and 7 students) will move to South Whidbey High School.

- Students in 7 and 8 will follow a typical middle school schedule.
- All 7 and 8th grade classrooms will be in the same section at SWHS separate from 9-12.
- All 7 and 8th grade students will have their own lunch time separate from 9-12 lunch.
- All 7 and 8th grade students will have lockers.
- The start and end time for school for 7 and 8 will be the same as grades 9-12
- All sports field and tennis courts will be available for 7-12 students
- All 7-12 students will have increased course opportunities over time
- A full time nurse for grades 7-12 on site

Students in grades 5 and 6 (current 4th and 5th grade students) will be located on the South campus (next to SWES, formerly called the Primary School).

- A secretary will be assigned full time to South Campus office on site
- A full time counselor will be assigned to serve grades 5-8 (office on South Campus)
- There will be a principal hired to serve grades 5-8.
- The K-6 program will have a full time art teacher
- The K-6 program will have two full time PE teachers
- Grade 5 and 6 students will use the SWES – North Campus cafeteria for lunch
- Grade 5 and 6 students will have access to all SWES – North fields and playgrounds
- Grade 5 and 6 students will have access to all SWES- North support services including library
- Teachers in grades 5 and 6 will work together and departmentalize and team teach our 5th and 6th grade students.
- There will be approximately 8 full time teachers in grades 5 and 6 in September 2017
- Middle school concept and similar schedule for all students
- The start and end time will be similar to grades 7-12 (to be determined)
- Separate lunch from k-4 program
- A full time nurse for grades K-6
